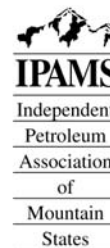

IPAMS, founded in 1974, is a non-profit trade association representing more than 400 independent oil and natural gas producers, service and supply companies, banking and financial institutions and industry consultants committed to environmentally responsible energy development in the Intermountain West.

IPAMS works to enable our members to more efficiently explore, develop, and produce oil and natural gas using environmentally-sound methods on private, state, federal, and Native American lands located in the thirteen state region of the Intermountain West. IPAMS is dedicated to representing, informing, educating and assisting its members, the public, and regulatory agencies on all issues affecting the oil and natural gas industry at the local, state and federal levels.

- Formed in 1974, IPAMS is a regional petroleum trade association representing the interests of hundreds of independent natural gas and oil producers, working interest owners, royalty owners, drilling contractors, oil field service and supply companies, and banking and financial institutions operating in the Intermountain West.
- IPAMS meets continually with federal and state legislators and regulators to urge public policy that fosters the environmentally sound development of domestic resources, lessening the nation's dependence on unstable (and often unfriendly) foreign sources of supply.
- IPAMS members give millions of dollars back to the communities and states in which they do business, providing high-paying jobs and helping to keep local and state taxes low.
- IPAMS members operate in the states of Arizona, Colorado, Idaho, Montana, Nebraska, Nevada, New Mexico, North Dakota, South Dakota, Oregon, Utah, Washington and Wyoming.
